Royal Court Theatre today announces the casting for Joel Tan's Scenes from a *Repatriation* directed by emma + pj. The cast includes Kaja Chan, Aidan Cheng, Jon Chew, Fiona Hampton, Robin Khor Yong Kuan and Sky Yang.

Scenes from a Repatriation is designed by TK Hay, with lighting design by Alex Fernandes, sound design by Patch Middleton and the movement director is Ken Nakajima. The casting director is Jatinder Chera, and the assistant designer is Yijing Chen. The production is directed by emma + pj, the collaboration between theatre makers Emma Clark and PJ Stanley.

The production runs from Friday 25 April 2025, until Saturday 24 May 2025 with press night on 30 April 2025.

'All of human history? It's basically people taking things from each other'

A 1000-year-old statue of the Boddhisattva Guan Yin lives in The British Museum.

When it emerges that the statue was stolen from its original home, the museum attempts to deflect both the public response and controversial repatriation claims from the Chinese government.

As statesmen scheme and grease their palms, beneath the statue witches dance, a cleaner prays, and spirits weep. Guan Yin's gaze falls over the broken shards of human life from empires old and new.

Joel Tan's shape-shifting play unfolds the statue's journey from China to Britain and back again, stirring up centuries of ghosts. Directed by experimental theatre-makers emma + pj *(Ghosts of the Near Future, Barbican),* Scenes from a Repatriation questions who can claim cultural artefacts – and why.

First Look Tickets (Previews) - as most of the plays we stage at the Royal Court have never been seen before, the first few performances in front of an audience are the final part of a long creative process that starts with the playwright. Our First Look Performances, which are sold at a reduced price, are an integral part of the process. If you book tickets for a First Look Performance - the first three previews of a new play - you'll be asked for your feedback which is then shared with the artistic team during the preview period, potentially influencing the final piece.

Under 30s Tickets – We're also extending our scheme for young audiences, with Under 27s ticket prices now available for ages 30 and under, meaning even more people can access even more tickets at the £15 rate. A number of £15 tickets will be available for selected performances in the Jerwood Theatre Downstairs. Available on Band C & D tickets, subject to availability.

Monday Tickets – Every Monday, every seat in the house for Jerwood Theatre Downstairs productions is available for £15 from 9am online. A limited number are available in advance, subject to availability, to Friends and Supporters. The same price is available every Monday for Jerwood Theatre Upstairs productions.

10p Standing - We will start to sell standing tickets for 10p from 6pm on the day of each performance. Patrons buying standing tickets must stand in the windows provided on the side of the auditorium on the circle level.
